Dear Dr Sharma ,

Again, congratulations on your selection as a recipient of the 2006 ChemRAWN XIV-GCI Developing and Emerging Nations grant. This year we are able to offer you \$10,000 in funding for your project to develop a green chemistry network in India.

As you know, the project criteria stated in the request for proposals description included:

- Potential to advance green chemistry in developing/emerging countries;
- Potential for collaboration and long-term relationship building between GCI Chapters;
- Potential to maximize impact by leveraging resources; and
- Long-term impact

It is also necessary that you comply with the following guidelines in utilizing your grant:

- Continually review your project scope and scale to ensure that the above four criteria are incorporated as fully as possible*;
- Use your funds within one calendar year of receipt (however, under extraordinary circumstances, no-cost extensions may be granted);
- Submit a one page report at six (6) months and a full report, not to exceed ten pages, at the completion of your project, describing what the funds were used for and the positive impact they had on your ability to achieve your objectives.
- Should this grant produce work that is accepted for publication in any journal, book, periodical, etc, kindly include the following acknowledgment: "This project is funded in part by a grant from the ChemRAWN XIV International Green Chemistry Grants Program."
